Open-Air Tent Mass Requirements

- For everyone's safety, carefully follow all directions from:
 - Staff and Traffic Directors
 - Volunteers
 - Posted signs, traffic cones, and warning tape
- Park only in marked stalls
- Do **not** go around cones, taped-off, or blocked-off areas
 - People will be walking, gathering, or sitting in designated areas
- Seating:
 - Individuals attending mass are always required to maintain a social-distance of six-feet or more from others
 - Families/groups from the same household may sit next to each other (within six feet)
 - At all other times, people from the same household are required to maintain a social distance of six feet, even between themselves and others
- Holy Communion
 - Wait for staff or volunteer directions
 - Face masks must be worn when receiving Holy Communion
 - Receive the Holy Communion by hand only, not by mouth or on the tongue
 - Immediately return to your seat or leave the area after receiving Holy Communion
- After Mass, do not congregate or remain in the area

By attending any Mass or Service at St. Thomas More, you agree to follow these requirements, affirm that you do not have any flu-like or COVID-19 symptoms, and indicate that you are healthy enough to wear a face covering for a prolonged period of time. You also acknowledge you are aware that:

There are risks of contracting COVID-19, a serious and potentially deadly illness, in any public gathering. While St. Thomas More has taken reasonable protective measures, St. Thomas More cannot accept responsibility for your personal decision to accept the risks indicated.
