Parking Lot Mass Requirements

- For everyone's safety, carefully follow all directions from:
 - Staff and Traffic Directors
 - Volunteers
 - Posted signs, traffic cones, and warning tape
- Remain in your vehicle
 - Face masks are required if you are outside of your vehicle for any reason
- Park only where directed to park
 - Park straight facing the church, not at angles (even if the lines indicate otherwise)
- At the end of mass, wait for staff and volunteers to direct you to exit
- Holy Communion will be distributed as you exit the parking lot
 - Face masks must be worn when receiving Holy Communion
 - Receive the Holy Communion by hand only, not by mouth or on the tongue
 - Take a moment to consume the Holy Communion safely, then leave immediately to allow others to receive the Holy Communion
 - Do **not** attempt to drive while consuming the Holy Communion

By attending any Parking Lot Mass at St. Thomas More, you agree to follow these requirements, affirm that you do not have any flu-like or COVID-19 symptoms, and indicate that you are healthy enough to wear a face mask for a prolonged period of time. You also acknowledge you are aware that:

- There are risks of contracting COVID-19 (a serious and potentially deadly illness) in any public gathering
 - While St. Thomas More has taken reasonable protective measures, St. Thomas More cannot accept responsibility for your personal decision to accept the risks indicated
- Attendance and participation are voluntary
 - Special Eucharist dispensation by the Archdiocese is still in effect
 - Masses are available online
